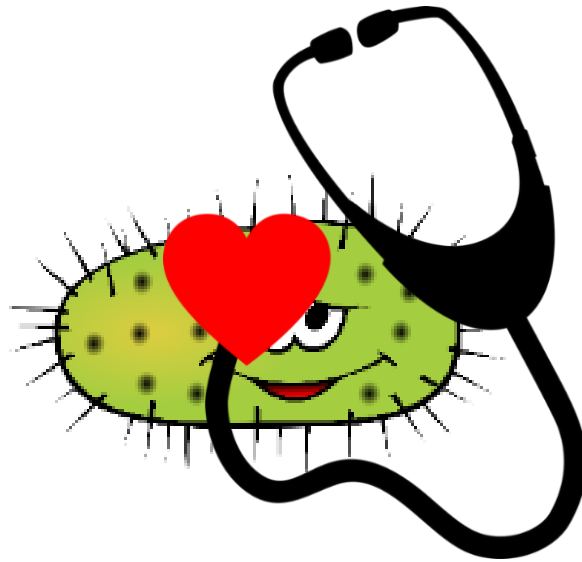




Doctor Maxine visits Happy Town

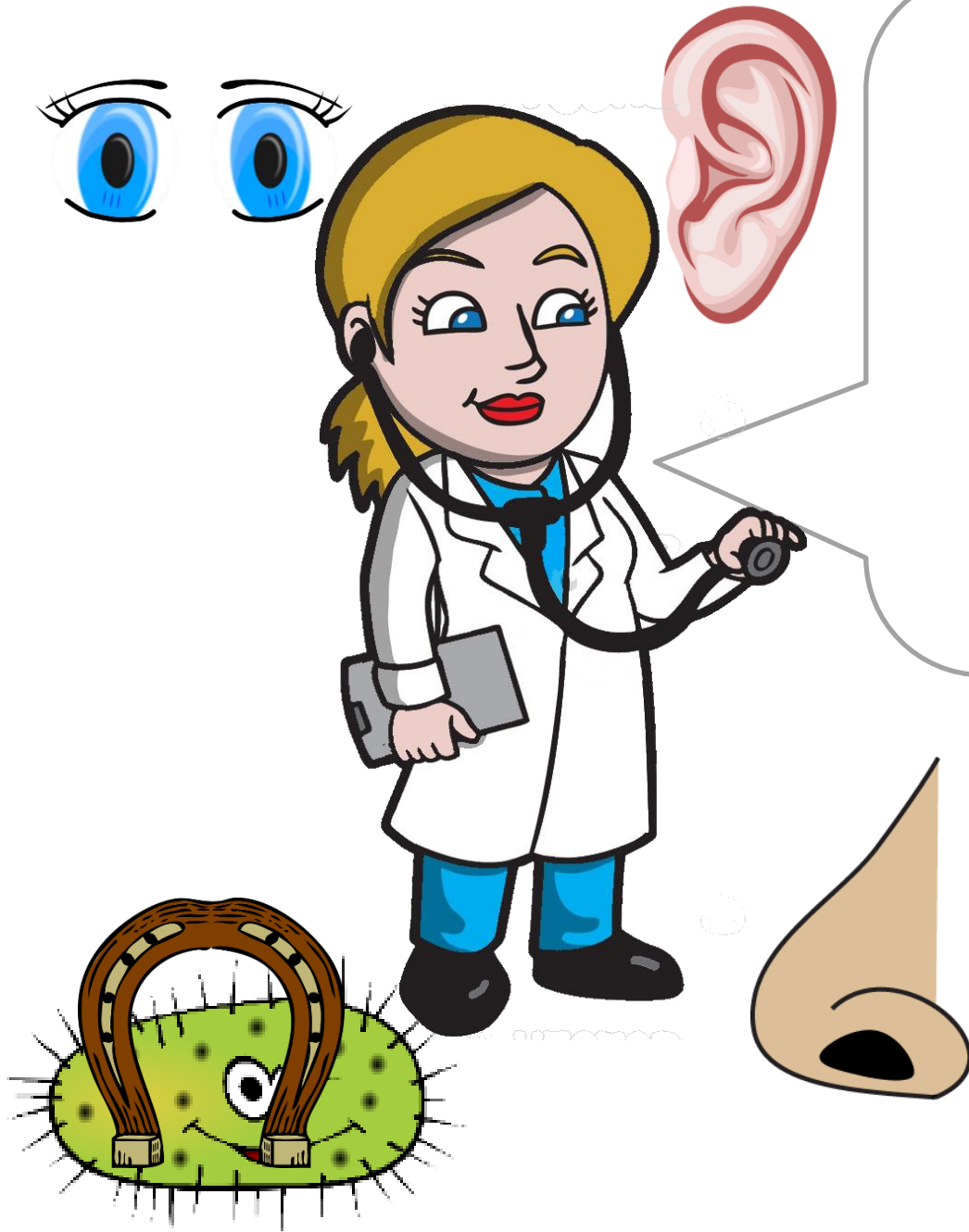




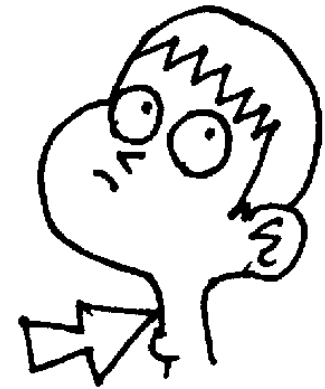
Find the bad bugs in our story

Everyone is excited. Who could it be?





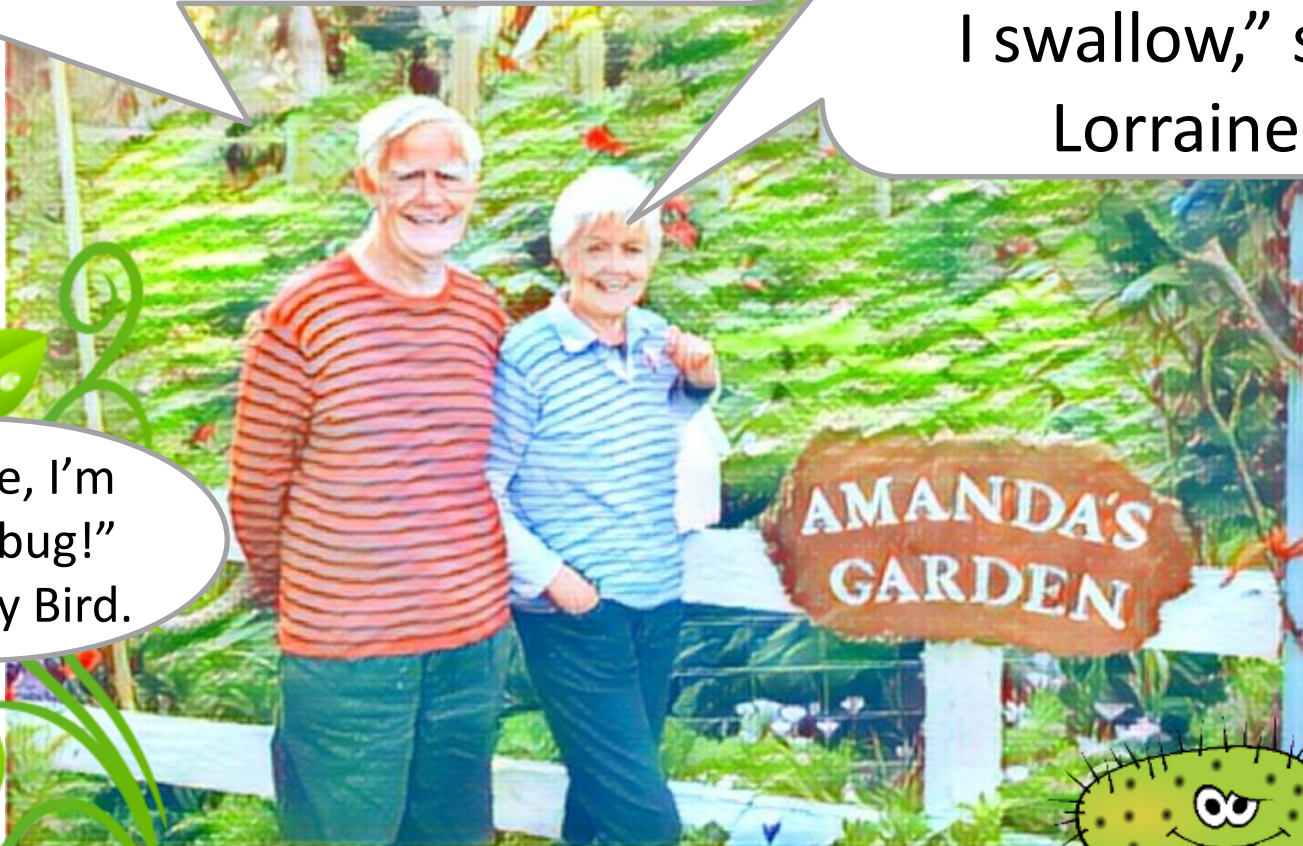
“It’s me, Doctor Maxine! I am going to check everyone’s eyes, ears, nose and throat.”

Lorraine.

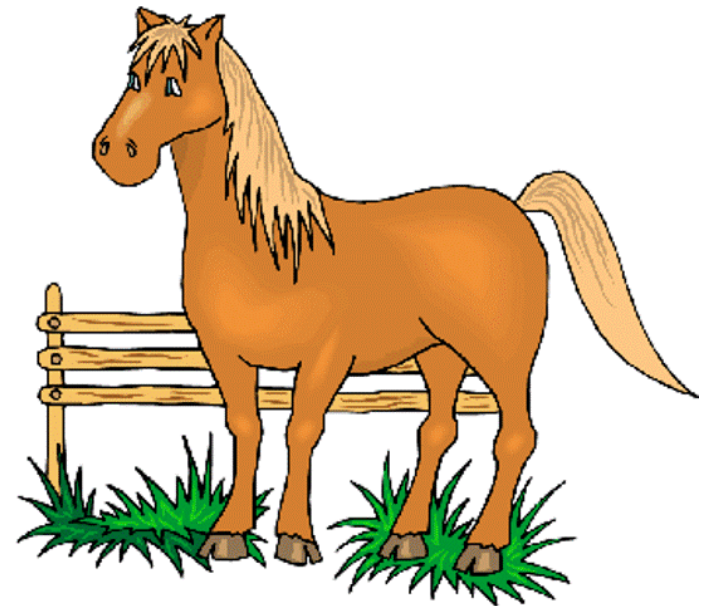
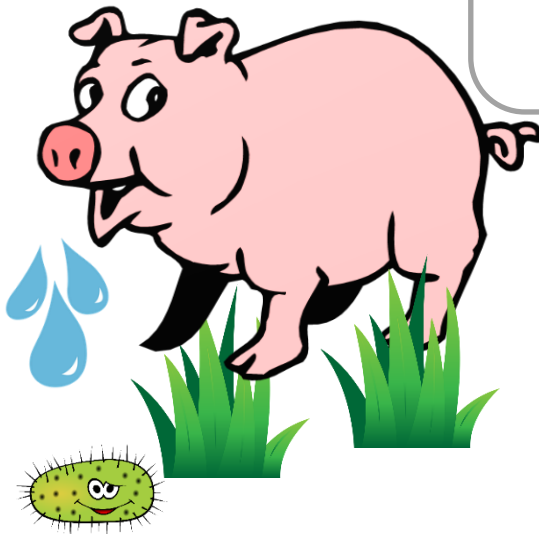
"Not me, I'm

I’ll ask Doctor Maxine to check your nose and throat too,” said Melrose Mare. “You may have a virus.”





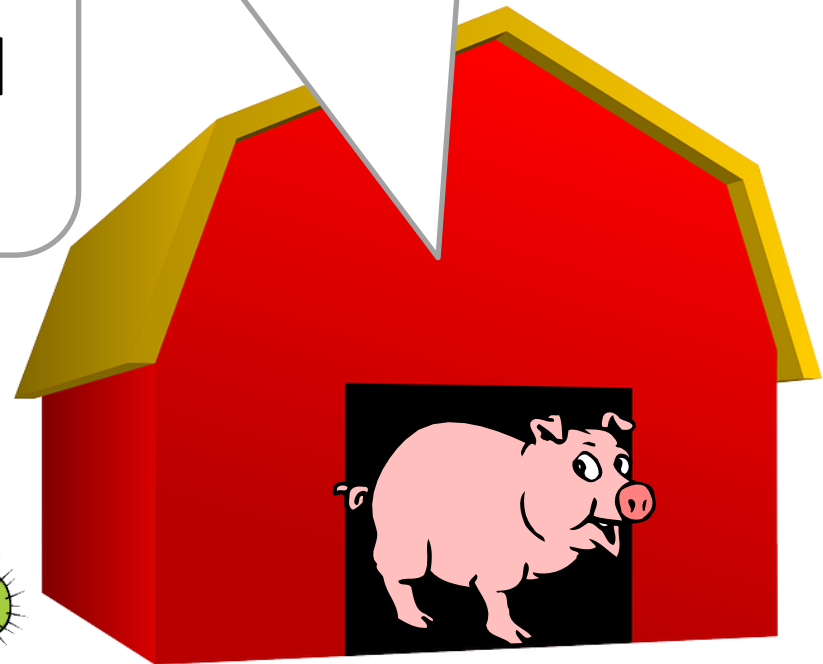
“You need to stay home and rest. Drink plenty of water and cover your coughs and sneezes,” said Doctor Maxine.

"I'm sorry friends. I can't leave home until I am healthy. We can play when I feel better," said Peter Pig.

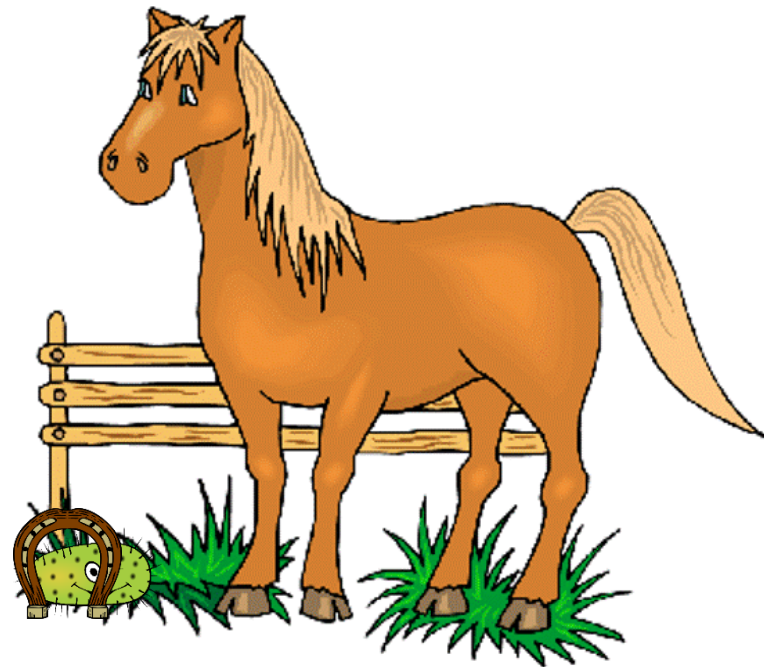
"Take care of yourself," said Daisy Cow.

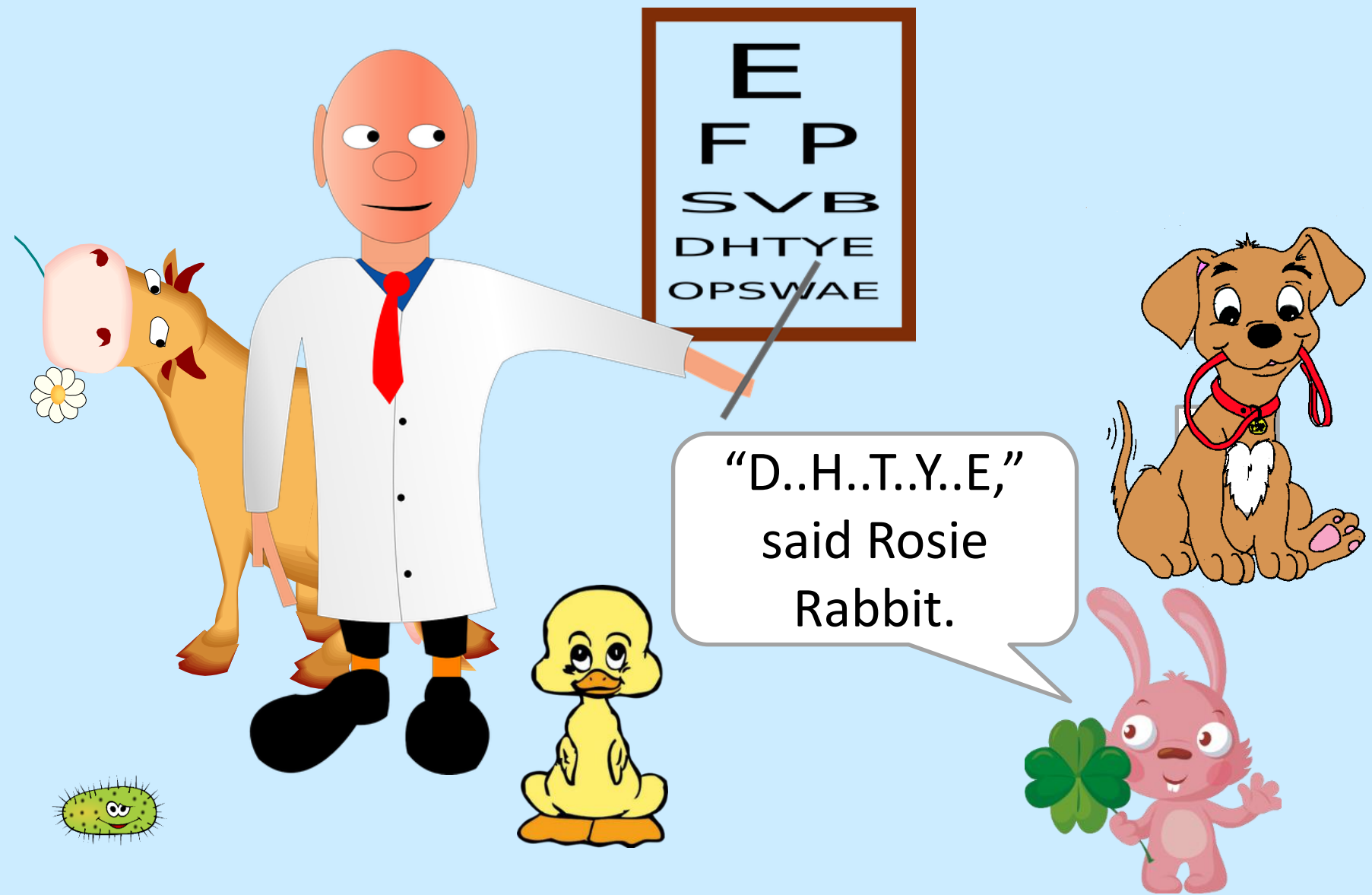




Nurse Nancy was very busy

Nurse Ned checked everyone's eyes.

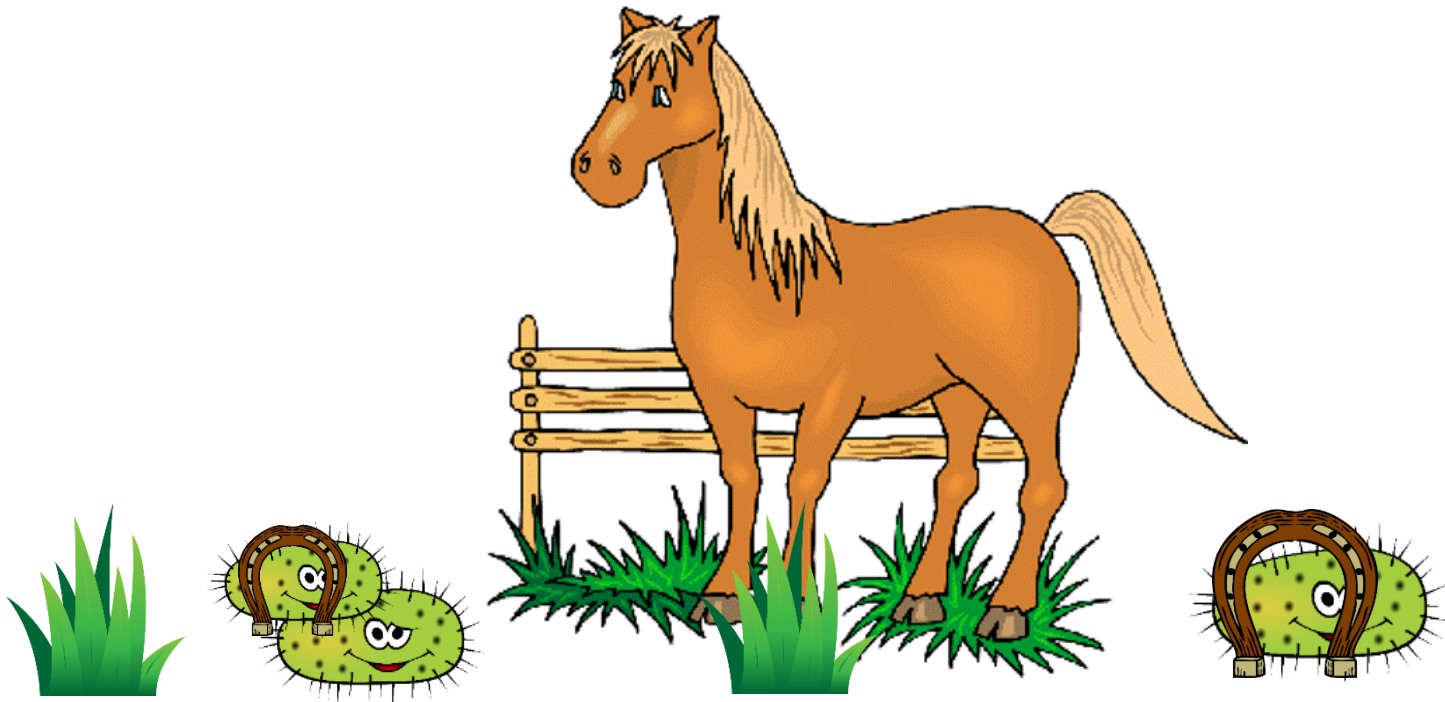
“I need to get glasses,” said Barry. “I couldn’t see all the letters on the chart.”

hungry now.”

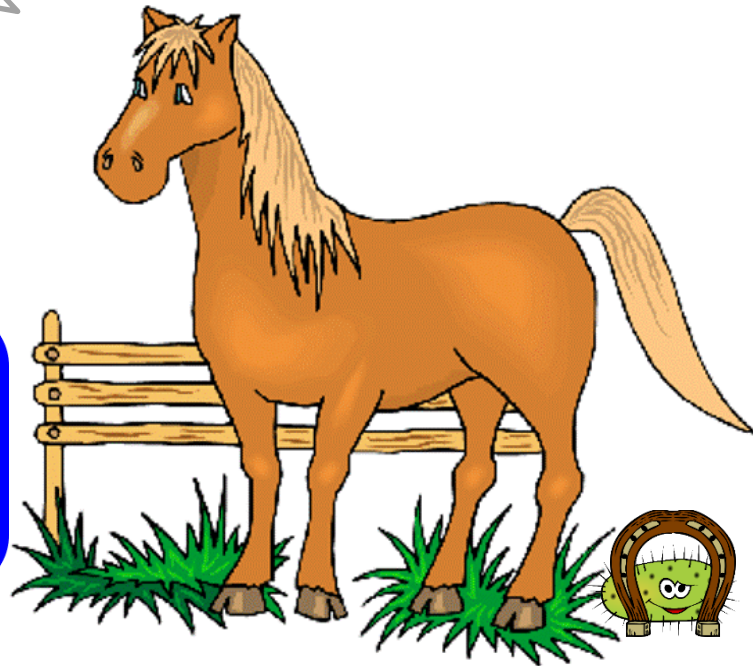


“Stomping out bad bugs has made me hungry too!” said Melrose Mare.

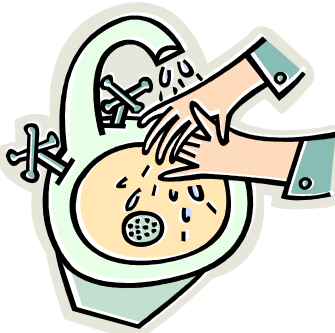

“One, wash your hands before you eat and after going to the toilet. **Two**, cover your coughs and sneezes and **three**, don’t share anything that has been in your mouth.”

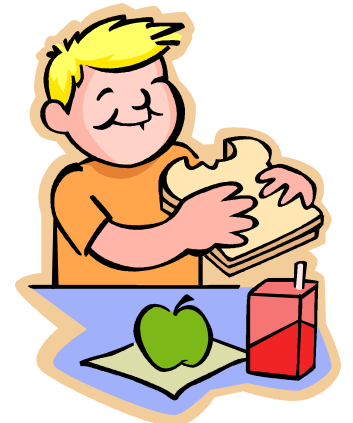

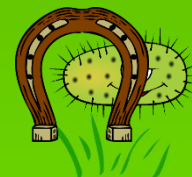


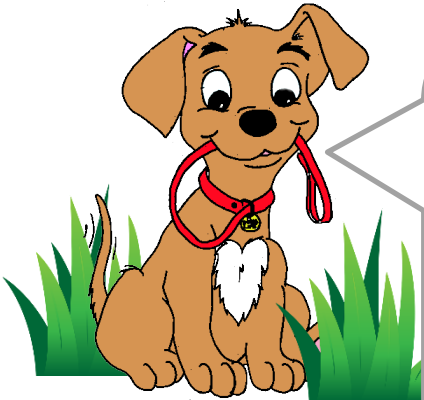
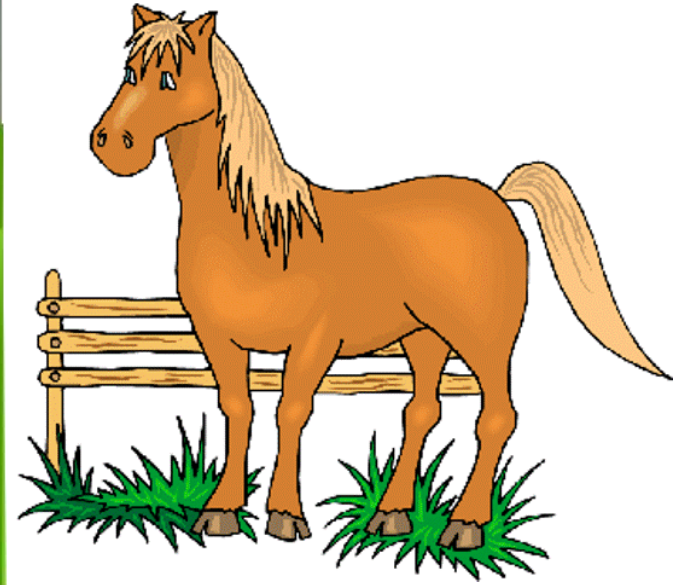
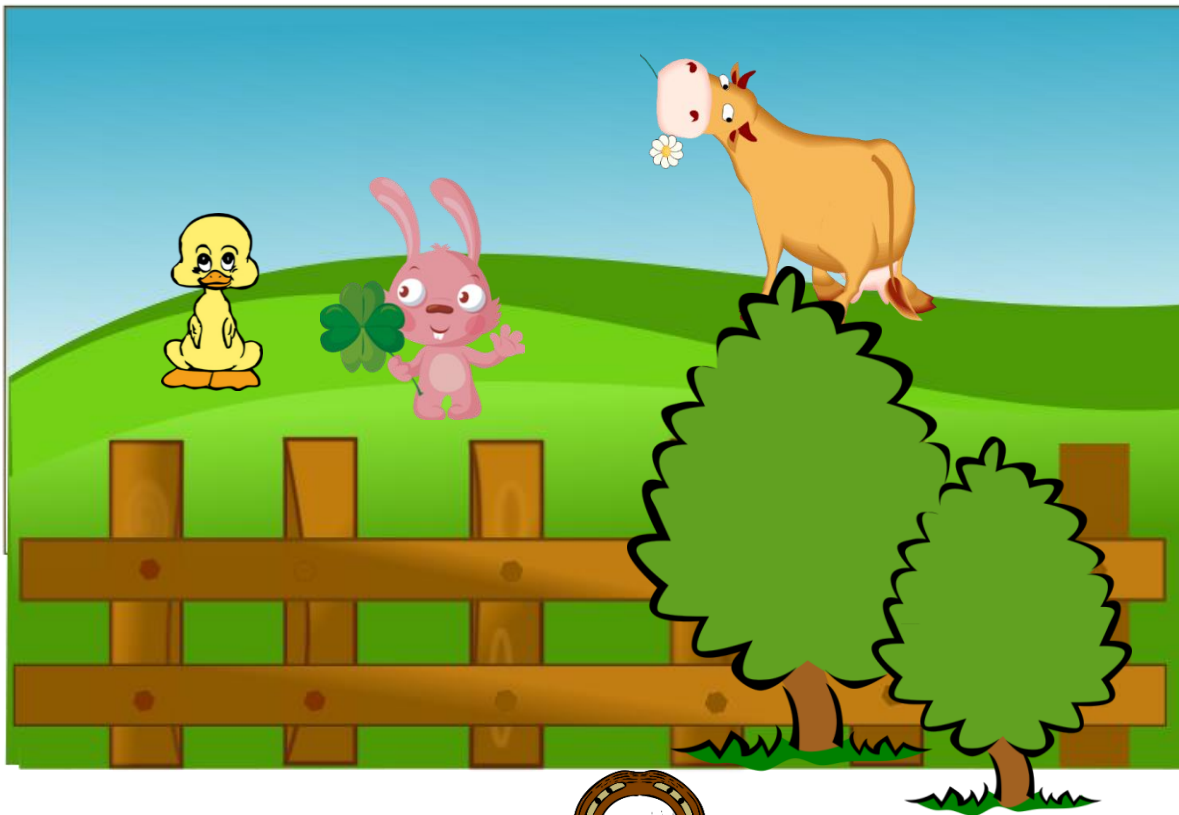
“Great,” said Melrose Mare. “We can have some fruit now. I see everyone has brought their own drink bottles – enjoy your snack!”

It was time to go home.



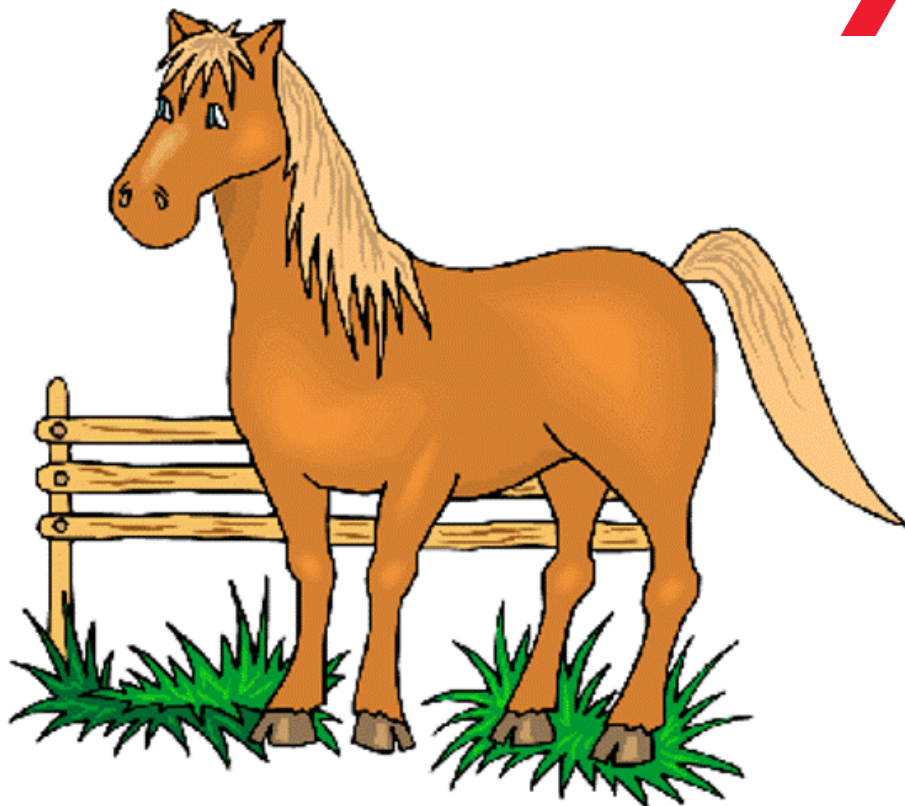


“Thank you for keeping us healthy and safe from bad bugs Melrose Mare,” said Dexter. “We hope Peter Pig is better soon. We miss him.”
